*You will hear 5 mobile phone messages. What is the main message of each speaker?  
Match the statements (A-F) with each message (1-5). There is one letter you do not need.*

*You will hear the recording twice.*

*You will now hear the speakers.*

Voice: Good morning. Clarence Hotel. Can I help you?

Female: Yes, I'd like to cancel my reservation.

Voice: Can I have your surname, please?

Female: It's Frean.

Voice: Could you spell it for me, please?

Female: Yes, it's F-R-E-A-N.

Female: I've seen it. What I really want to see is the photo exhibition at the Museum of Arts and Crafts.  
Male: Well, it's too late for that. The museum closes at seven and it's 7:30 now. I guess we can still go to a café for a hot drink and a nice chat.  
Female: But on Thursdays the museum's open till 10.  
Male: Well, it's Thursday today. Let's go then.

Male: Hello, I'd like a single room for tonight. How much is it?

*You now have 30 seconds to look at questions 11 to 15.*

[30 seconds pause]

*You will now hear the conversation.*

Jeff: Hi Nancy. Are you free on Sunday?  
Nancy: No, I'm not. I'll be on a trip. I'm going to London.  
Jeff: Oh, you lucky thing. So you'll have a holiday.  
Nancy: Well, not really.  
Jeff: No? So why are you going there?

Nancy: It's because of my work. I have to go to a seminar about marketing. My boss wants me to get some new ideas. But I've got a good friend in London, so I'll take the opportunity to visit her.

Jeff: So when are you leaving?

Nancy: Well, the seminar's on Friday and I want to arrive the day before. And then I'll stay Saturday with my friend and come back Sunday, so I'll be away from Thursday to Sunday.

Jeff: And where will you stay?

Nancy: Well, I'll be away for three nights, and I'll stay in the hotel for the first two and then the third night I'll stay with my friend.

Jeff: Which hotel is that?

Nancy: Oh, it's a hotel and conference centre next to the airport. You see, most of the people at the seminar will fly to London, so it's good for them. Personally, I'd prefer one nearer the city centre. The best would be in the centre itself.

Jeff: Is the hotel expensive?

Nancy: I'm sure it is. It's probably a little too expensive for me. But the company is paying for it, so it won't cost me anything.

Jeff: That's good. Anyway, have a nice trip.

Nancy: Thanks.

*Now turn to Task 4, questions 16 to 20.*

*You will hear a tour guide talking to a group of tourists.*

*For questions 16-20, choose the correct answer, A, B or C. You will hear the speaker twice.*

*You now have 30 seconds to look at questions 16 to 20.*

[30 seconds pause]

*You will now hear the speaker.*

Speaker: And now to the City Market.

Let's look at your city maps. We're in Old Street now. We want to go to Park Street, where the market is. So we need to go down South Street.

As you can see, it's a long way to walk and there've been problems with the bus service recently, so we'll take the tube.

Some years ago the City Market was just a street market with cheap souvenirs. Today it is famous for the designer label clothing you can buy there. For those of you interested in books, there are excellent bookshops next to the market.

If you need some refreshment, there are several kiosks where you can grab a sandwich. There are some salad bars, but they are expensive. You must try the strawberry ice-cream at *Giorgio's*. It's fantastic!

The shops close at half past six. We have to leave at six fifteen if we don't want to miss our dinner at seven.
