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## ÁLTALÁNOS UTASÍTÁSOK

Figyelmesen olvassa el az összes utasítást és kövesse azokat.

Ne lapozzon, és ne oldja meg a feladatokat, amíg az ügyeletes tanár azt jóvá nem hagyja.

A vizsga összekötési feladatokból, többszörös választási lehetőségű feladatokból és kiegészítendő feladatokból áll.

- Az összekötési feladatokban **mindegyik** számmal jelölt tartalmat kösse össze a azzal a megfelelő tartalommal, amely betűvel van megjelölve (1-es és 4-es feladatok).
- A többszörös választási lehetőségű feladatokban a több felkínált válasz közül csak egyet válasszon ki (2-es és 5-ös feladatok).

Segítségként, a feladatok megoldásakor írhat ennek a vizsgafüzetnek az oldalain.

**A pontos válaszokat X jellel kell megjelölnie a válaszadó lapon.**

- A rövid válaszok feladatában (feladat 3) és a kiegészítendő feladatokban (feladat 6) írjon be a hiányzó tartalmat. A válaszokat **csak** a kijelölt helyre írja be ebben a vizsgafüzetben. Ne töltsen ki a pontozási helyet. Írjon olvashatóan. Az olvashatatlan válaszokért nulla (0) pont jár.

Az Írás vizsga fogalmazás feladatból áll. A fogalmazást írja meg a mellékelt utasítás követésével. Írhat a vázlatlapon, de annak tartalmára nem jár pont. **A fogalmazást feltétlenül a tisztázati lapra írja.** Írjon olvashatóan. Az fogalmazásra nulla (0) pont jár, ha nagy nyomtatott betűkkel vagy olvashatatlanul van megírva. Használjon kizárólag golyóstollat, amellyel kék vagy fekete színnel lehet írni! Amikor megoldotta a feladatokat, ellenőrizze a válaszokat. Ha az írásnál hibát követ el, a hibát tegye zárójelekbe, húzza át és lássa el rövidített aláírással. **Tilos aláíratkozni teljes névvel és vezetéknévvel.**
