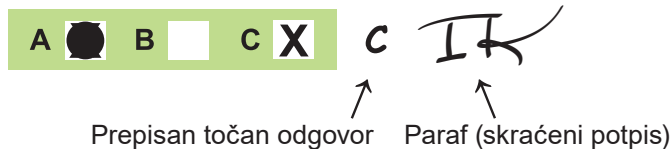

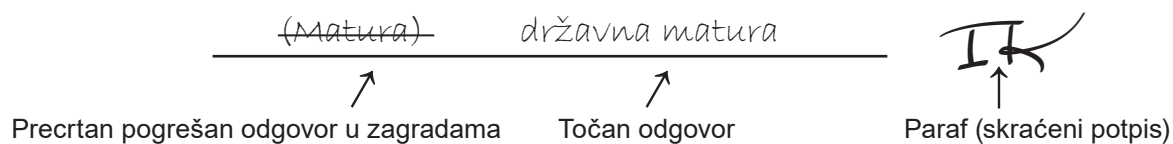

**The World's Least Visited Country Is Sinking**

Famous destinations like Spain or Italy see millions of tourists annually. Tuvalu is nothing like them. Its pre-pandemic all-time high came in 2019, when 3,000 tourists visited its nine islands. That dropped to 41 in 2021, increasing to 3,600 in 2023 and only just exceeding 2,500 in 2024.

Tuvalu consists of 9 coral islands spread across 26 km<sup>2</sup> of the Pacific, between Australia and Hawaii. Despite being the world's least-visited country, it has a tourist industry. Visitors can catch one of two weekly flights from Fiji or the Sunday air route from Kiribati and enjoy diving, buying handcrafts, and seeing historical sites.

Several thousand years ago, Polynesian sailors from Fiji, Samoa and Tonga reached the islands. However, each of Tuvalu's inhabited islands has a different answer as to who came first. The people of Niutao claim their ancestors were Samoans, as do the people of Funafuti and Vaitupu. On Nanumea, oral history remembers people from Tonga settling first.

Europeans passed by in the 16th century but didn't stay. In the 1880s, Germany showed an interest in owning Tuvalu but didn't do much about it. In the 1890s Tuvalu became a British protectorate and in 1916 a colony together with the Gilbert Islands. Tuvalu's final freedom came in 1978.

The future, however, is uncertain. Most of Tuvalu is only one metre above the sea. Because of global warming and rising sea levels, 90% of the land may be under water by 2100. Australia and New Zealand offer visas to Tuvaluans, and children in school learn about emigration to prepare for the move.

Still, Tuvalu aims to live on, even if the land sinks. The government is developing a complete online version of the country – a permanent home for its history, tradition and culture.

### Tile Whipping

### How to Make Better Coffee

Coffee is always worth drinking if made properly.
